Hold near Meadows Cafe Area since it will not be occupied at that point Volunteers will be needed, a form will be sent out for that. Just need Chris to confirm




- Majority wants some coffee option (see below)

The following information is a select all that apply. I asked respondents to select every option that appeals to them.




Other notes:

Issue with installation. Call maintenance and see if the installation is correct or not.

HVAC is dependent on the temperature outside. If it is lower than a threshold, heating turns on, if it is higher than the threshold, the ac turns on. You can turn off the system. If you turn everything off, the system would completely turn off.
